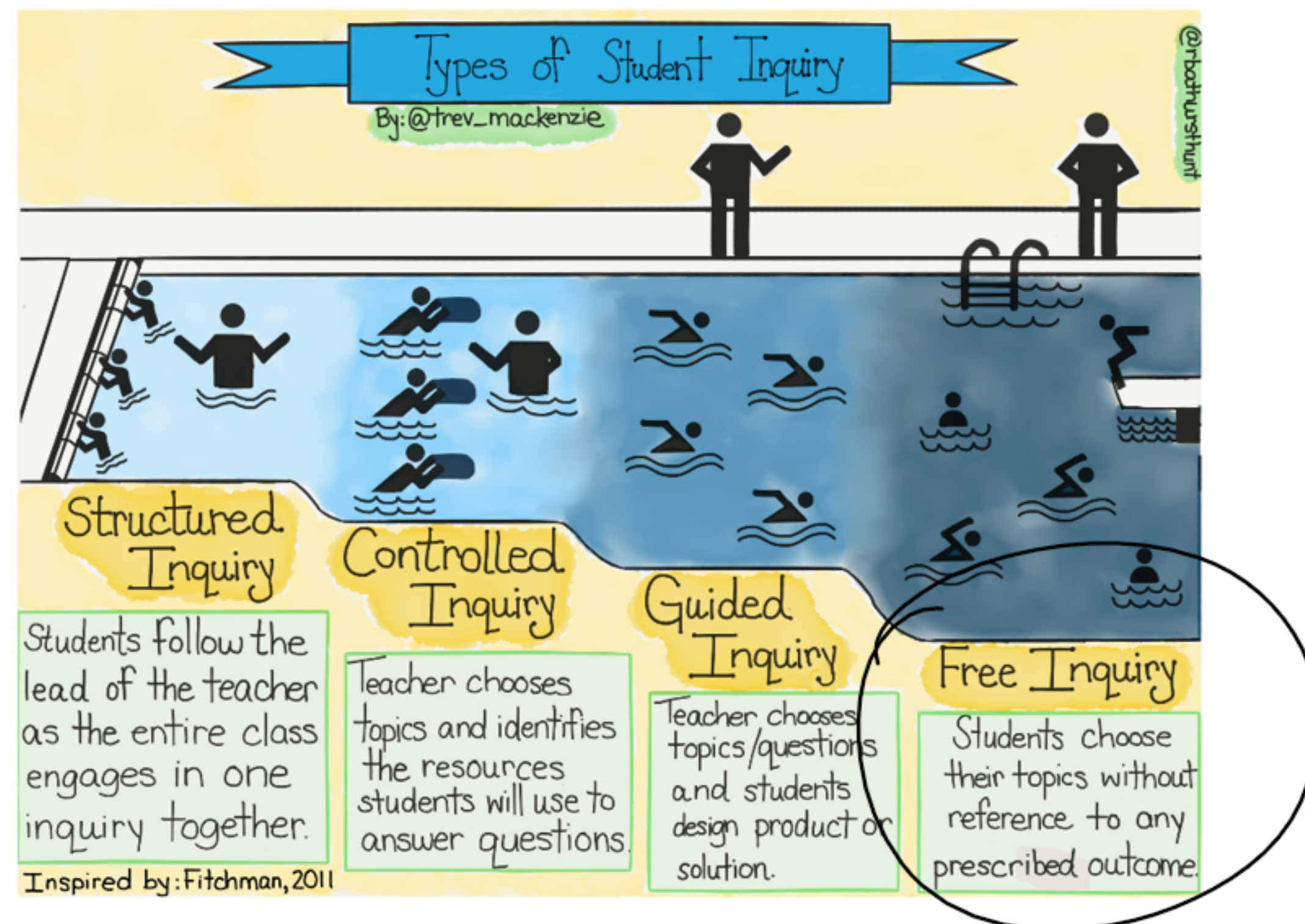


# Psych 30 Inquiry Project Assignment

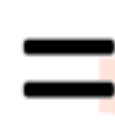
## Initial Source

You can view/skim some video examples to see what techniques and formatting of their videos they used to best capture their audience's attention and draw a wide audience to spread their message.

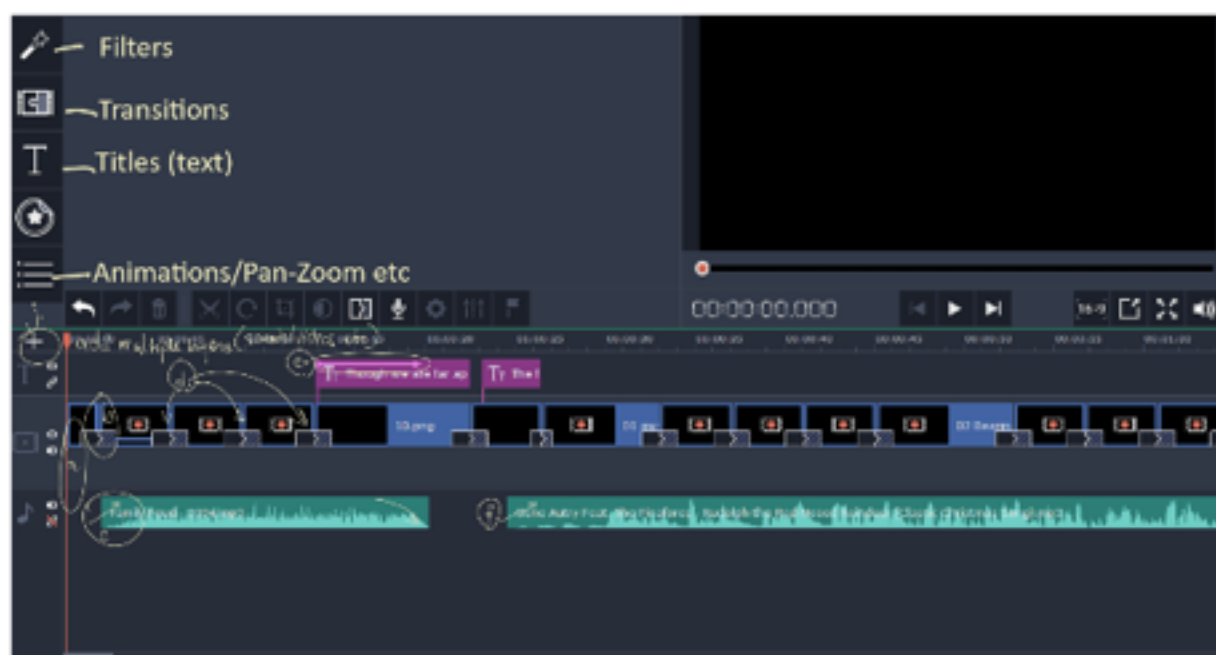

The following videos have been shared by former students who understand seeing a sample of a project helps give you a good idea of how to develop one yourself.

#### Types of Video Tools Your Program Should Provide



Technique examples in making this video you may notice:

- it starts with a black screen with no sound for a few seconds
- transitions into a short video clip
- music begins at the same time as the video clip but it fades in, so it doesn't start at exactly the same time
- there are transitions used between images/video clips - they are mostly all the same transition with similar time to transition, so it doesn't create distraction but uniformity
- text is added and also uses an animation - to scroll across a screen
- one music track is used at the beginning and fades out shortly after, while another music track begins softly and builds
- one thing not shown in this sample is adding in photos - varying between video and images
- another thing not added for this project were sound effects or other sound layers of a conversation/narration over the video
- note: your program should also allow you to separate the audio from a video file, so you can use audio sound while you change the image or even use the video imagery while you change the sound, lower the sound and do a voice over etc.
- you can also layer videos over each other, sometimes, or layer sounds (narrations + sound effects + music layers)
